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HOW TO EXPRESS NEGATION?

Manually (ignoring non-manual markers)

Manual negator is obligatory

MOTHER BOOK BUY NOT *MOTHER BOOK BUY

'Mother didn't buy a book' Intended: 'Mother didn't buy a book'

Manual negator follows the predicate

MOTHER BOOK BUY NOT *MOTHER BOOK NOT BUY

'Mother didn't buy a book' Intended: 'Mother didn't buy a book'

Manual negator has clause-final position

Non-manually

- Non-manual marking is a headshake or a sideward head turn.
- Non-manual marking is obligatory

_____neg
MOTHER BOOK BUY NOT *MOTHER BOOK NOT BUY

'Mother didn`t buy a book' Intended: 'Mother didn`t buy a book'

- Non-manual marking obligatorily accompanies over the predicate and manual negator
- Non-manual marking also may spread over subject and object

THE WORD ORDER CHANGE

The basic word order (Kimmelman 2012)

SVO for plain and agreeing verbs

SOV for classifier predicates

Word order in negative constructions

SOV Neg

V + NEG = SINGLE UNIT PHONOLOGICAL EVIDENCE

Properties of compound

The loss of repetition in the first part

One mouthing along a compound


Properties of [V Neg]-unit

- The loss of repetition of the predicate
- Mouthing change

Since the grammar of Russian language, where the negative particle precedes the verb, somehow influences on RSL, the mouthing over the predicate and the manual negation initials with pronouncing 'not' and then the predicate.




RSL

- NOT and NEVER do not appear in the same sentence (with negative meaning) unless NOT incorporated in V
- In the sentence with NEVER there is no non-manual negation above the V => What in the head of the NegP?



BOY CL:GLASS.DRINK EMPTY

'A boy has drunk the whole glass to the bottom.'



BOY CL:GLASS.DRINK NOT

'A boy has not drunk the glass.'
